

Wyoming AIS Updates

- All 2023 veliger tow sampling negative
- Increased staffing on western border in response to Idaho mid-Snake dreissenid mussel finding
- 12,674 inspections to date in 2024
 - 1,193 high risk
 - 251 decons
 - 5 mussel fouled boats

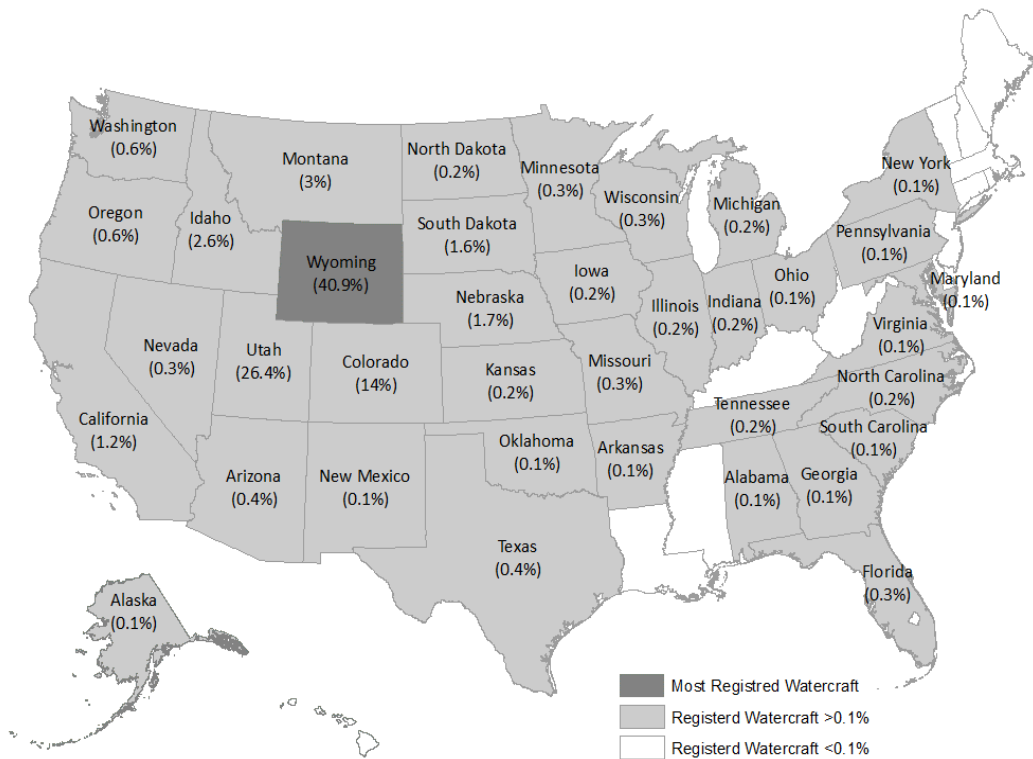


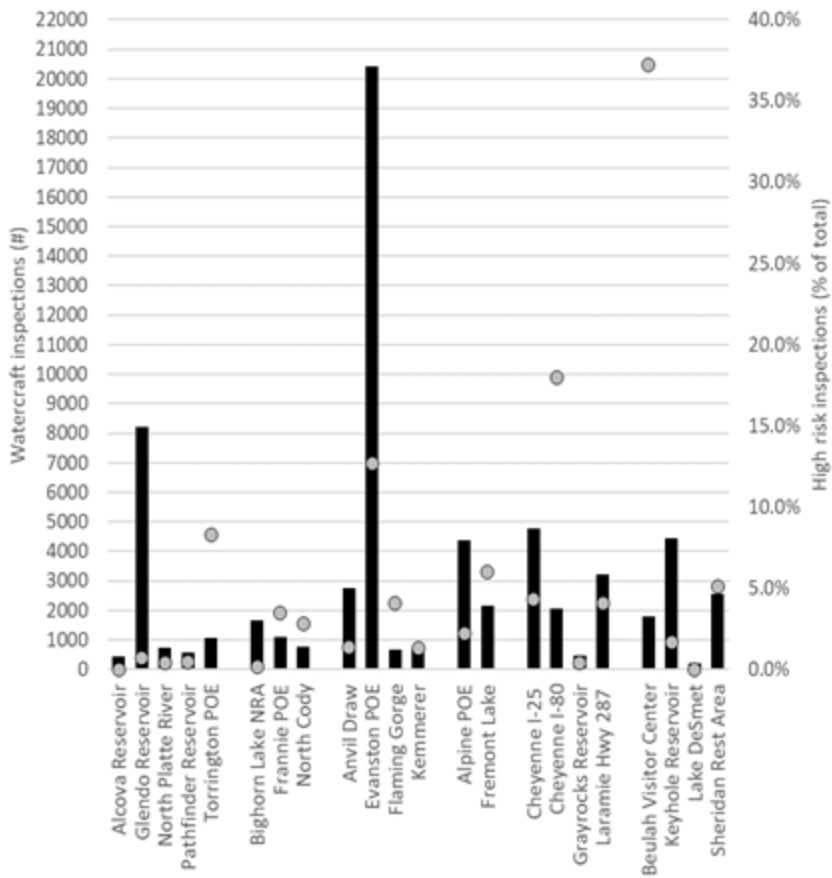


LAST WATER HISTORY

59.1% of boats last used out-of-state

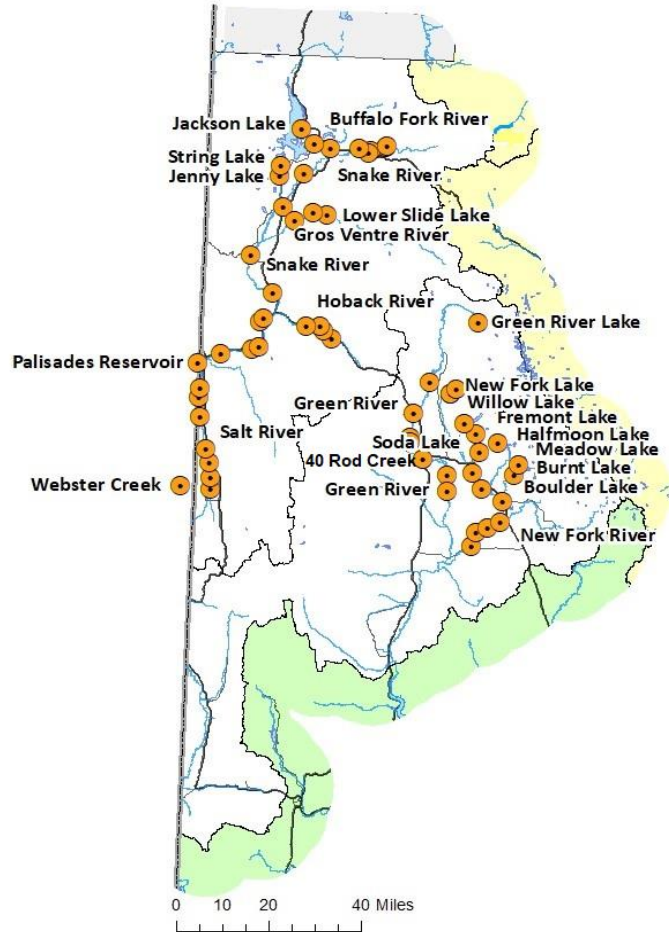
- Majority of watercraft originating outside of Wyoming came from Utah & Colorado
- 1,809 different last waters, 686 of these positive for ZQM





2023 WATERCRAFT INSPECTION DATA

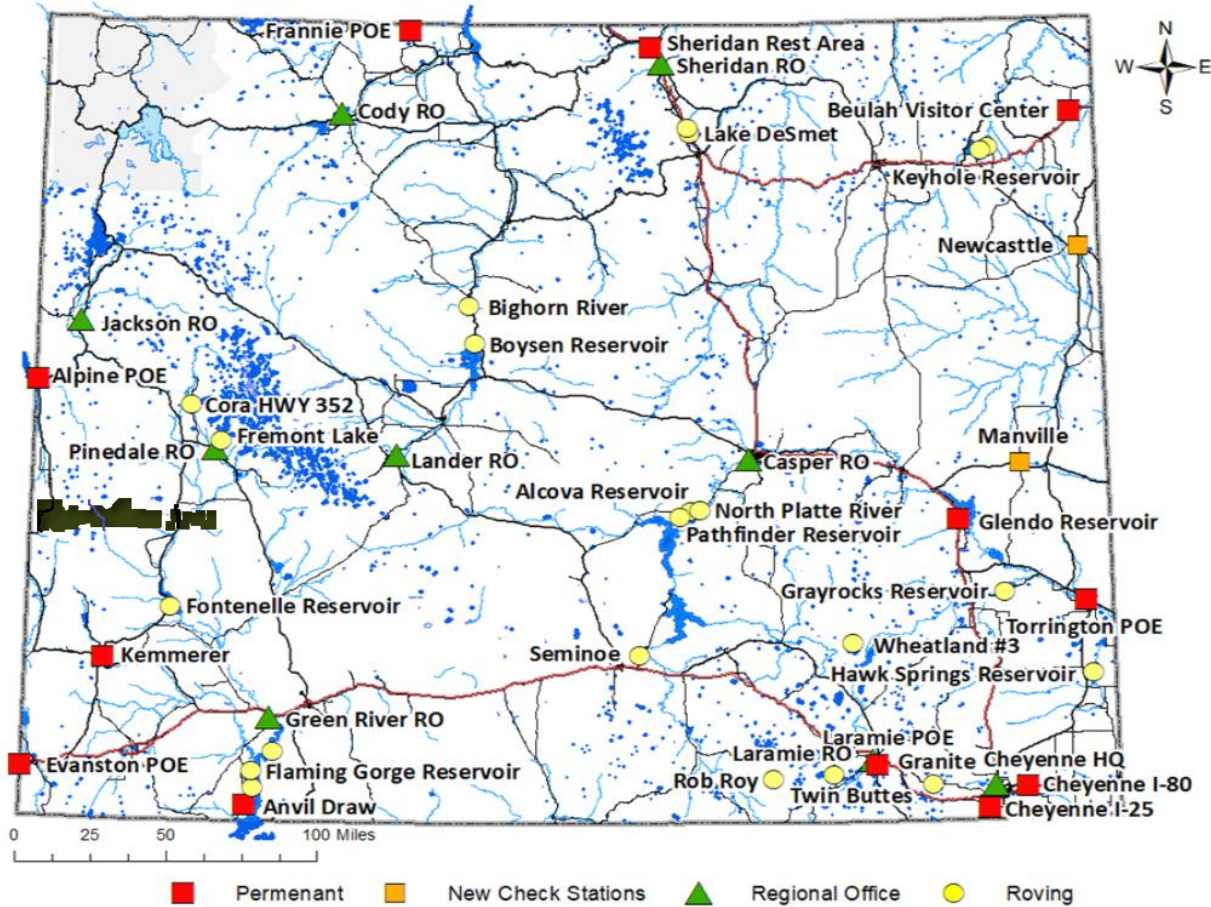
- 73,606 inspections (11% increase)
- 7,417 high risk inspections (55% increase)
- 1,154 decontaminations, 28 destined for Snake River basin
- 64 mussel boats, 0 mussel fouled boats destined for Snake River basin
