

2018 Check Stations

- Once again @ Spokane & Plymouth
- Opened on Monday April 2nd & running till October 31st (*almost 2 more months)
- Expanded days & hours of operation
 - Spokane now 7 days a week & Hours; 6:00am 8:00pm full season
 - Plymouth April, May, ¾ of September, & October 5 days a week; 9:00am-6:00pm
 In June, July, August, & ¼ of September 7 days a week, same hours
- Goal of 100+% increase in check station days
 (432+ days)
- Additional "roving" stations will occur June, July, & August
- To meet the goal we have significantly increased staffing;
 - One Sci Tech 3 (field supervisor) ** quality control!
 - Twelve Sci Tech 2's (watercraft inspectors)


The "old" State Line Rest Stop. Access via I-90 Exit (#299)

- Technician Job descriptions now too include maintenance & up keep!






