STANDARD PERMIT FORM FOR INTRA/INTERSTATE TRAVEL FOR NON-DIVISIBLE OVERSIZE AND/OR OVERWEIGHT LOADS

Special Restrictions

All bridge, highway, and seasonal postings must be observed regardless of permit routing. Before making this move, check seasonal postings at www.maine.gov/mdot/postedroads/.

Valid for daylight travel only.

Before making this move, go to www.newengland511.org, click on "Incident", "Road Restrictions", and "Driving Conditions" for restriction and inclement weather information. If driving conditions on permitted route are considered "Difficult" or "Ice/Hazardous", the overlimit movement must wait until conditions improve.

1 Pilot Escort is Required.

Per Rule Chapter 157, carrier must have all required flags, lights, and signs.

PLEASE NOTE: Individual municipalities may have restrictions and permitting systems in place and will need to be contacted.

Call Before You Haul: if this watercraft is destined for Washington, Oregon, Idaho, or Montana, carrier must contact the Pacific States Marine Fisheries Commission (PSMFC) to make arrangements to have your watercraft inspected and if need be, decontaminated.
